

ERS WATCHDOG PRODUCTIVITY MONITORING



DO YOU KNOW IF YOUR EMPLOYEES ARE TRULY BEING PRODUCTIVE?

ERS Watchdog will allow you to monitor your employee's activity on their work computers / laptops once they have clocked IN for work, giving a clear indication of which sites / applications / programs were accessed and for which period of time.

You have full control over which programs are seen as Productive or Unproductive, and certain sites or applications can be blocked, immediately clocking the employee OUT for work, once accessed. The employee is also clocked OUT if they have been inactive for a certain period of time. This will allow you to generate a report on exactly how many hours an employee is truly working.

ERS Watchdog is online and needs no hardware to install. Once the employee is done working for the day, they can clock OUT and are free to access any site / application / program.

COMPREHENSIVE REPORTS

Generate Reports on exactly which programs / sites / applications are used and the duration of activities. Reports can be categorised as Productive and Unproductive and are grouped.



LINKS TO T&A

Employees can clock IN or OUT for work on the app, either at the office of working from home. Comments can be added if additional info is required.



ALERTS

Set up programs / sites / applications that are seen as unproductive or are not permitted and automatically warn an employee if these are accessed via a pop-up screen.
